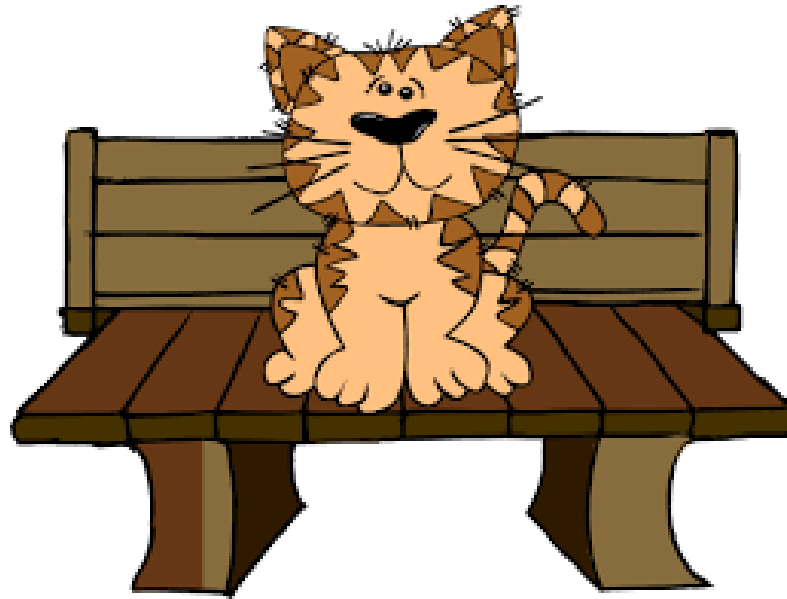


In



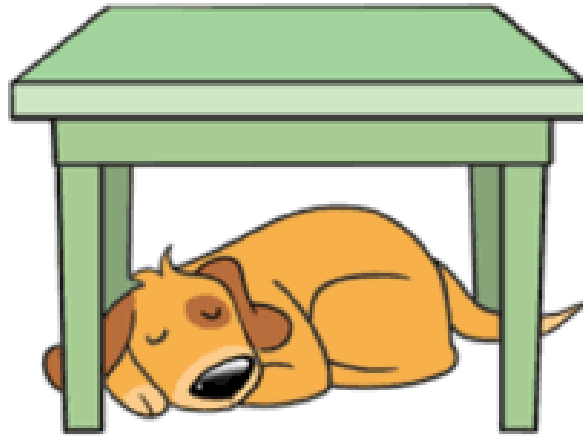
The cat is in the box.

Under



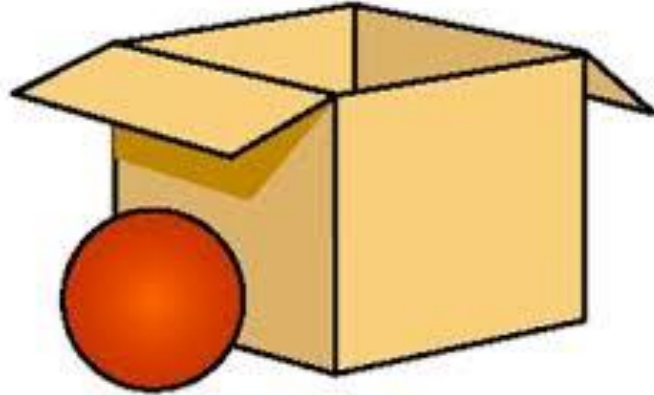
The dog is under the table.

Above



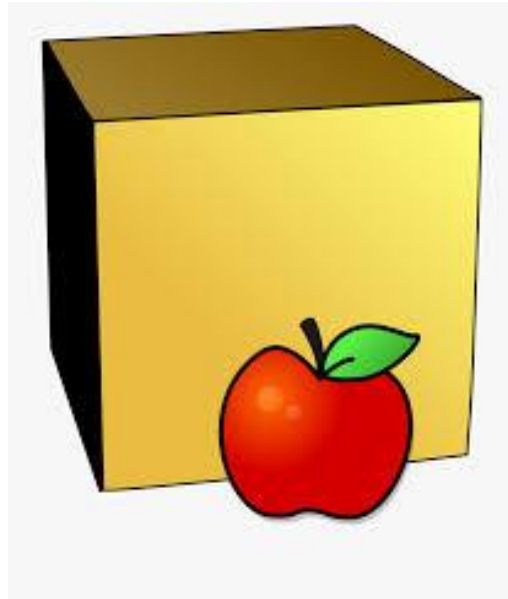
The butterfly is above the flowers.

Beside



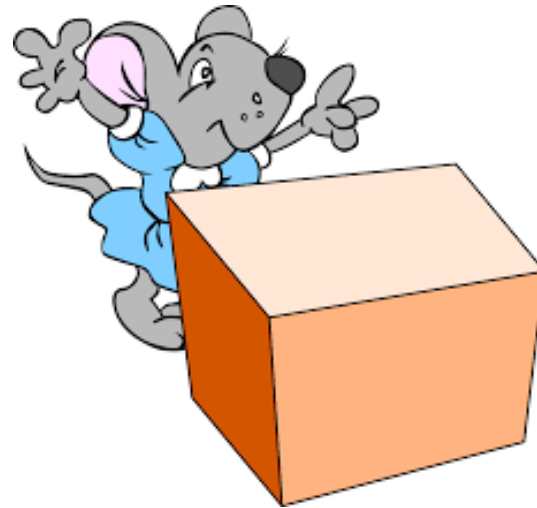
The ball is beside the box.

In front of



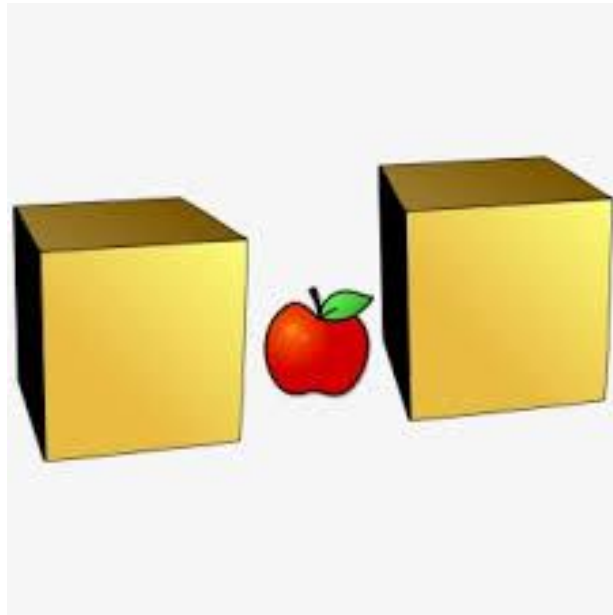
The apple is in front of the box.

Out of



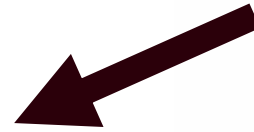
The ball is out of the box.

Toward



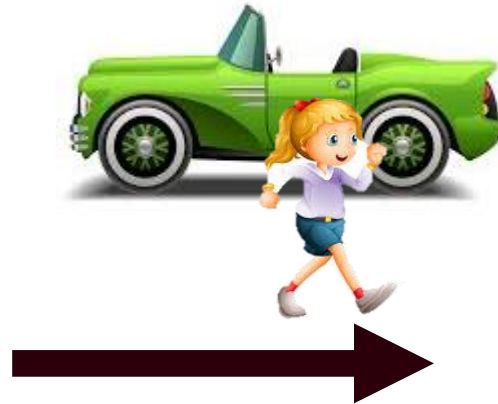
She walks toward the car.

Away from



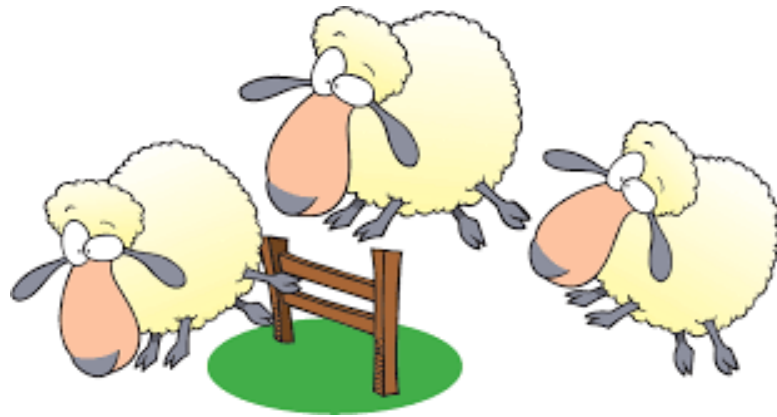
She walks away from the car.

Around



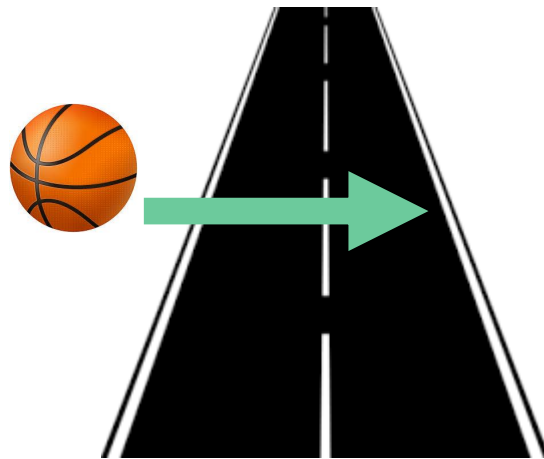
He runs around the bush.
